You will need to demonstrate how you engaged with supply chain partners to ensure the project's success.

Consultant of the Year – North

This award is for the consultant who has shown a clear investment in the training, upskilling, and wellbeing of their organisation while ensuring the successful delivery of projects. You will need to demonstrate your commitment to supporting public sector initiatives such as social value, value for money, and stakeholder management.

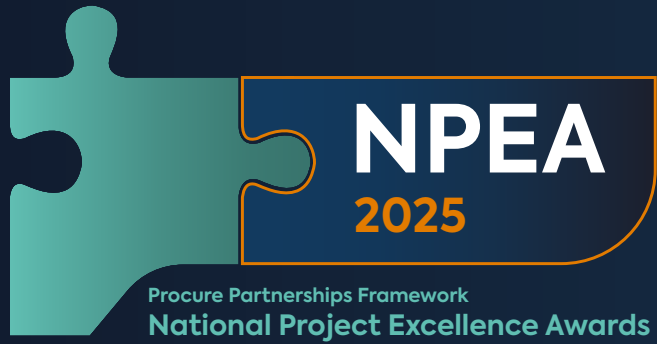
